Practice Sheet and Stationery

Start your practice with a pangram (a sentence that uses every letter of the alphabet):

A quick brown fox jumps over the lazy dog.

When you're ready, write a letter. There are two stationery designs on the following pages. Each one has two versions, lined and unlined. Use the style you prefer—and add color if you like.
